Oakland County Commissioners Eric Coleman and Janet Jackson will host a special free Child I.D. Day Event. At this special event City of Southfield Police Department will photograph, finger print and provide other valuable information that will be given to parents and guardians. The event will be held:

In conjunction with the Child ID event, Commissioners Coleman and Jackson will submit a resolution on May 25th, before the entire Oakland County Board of Commissioners to commemorate National Missing Children's Day in the county. This resolution will encourage residents to "**Take 25 Minutes**" to talk to their children about safety. This effort is an attempt to prevent a child from becoming one of the nearly 800,000 children that are reported missing by the U.S. Department of Justice each year.

Our resolution and Child ID Day event are intended to bring awareness to the fact that Child Safety is so important. Especially, now more than ever, with the advent of the internet which has become increasingly used as a tool for child predators.
